However, to everyone's surprise, the donkey quieted down after a few shovelfuls of dirt landed on his back.	Porém, para surpresa de todos, o burro aquietou-se depois de umas quantas pás de terra que levou.
The farmer looked to the bottom of the well and was amazed.	O camponês olhou para o fundo do poço e se surpreendeu.
With each shovelful of dirt that fell on his back, the donkey shook it off and took a step up on the very dirt that had fallen.	A cada pá de terra que caía sobre suas costas o burro a sacudia, dando um passo sobre esta mesma terra que caía ao chão.
In this way, before long, the donkey managed to reach the mouth of the well, climb over the edge, and trot away.	Assim, em pouco tempo, o burro conseguiu chegar até a boca do poço, passar por cima da borda e sair dali trotando.
